

## Ten ways to improve your site's accessibility

1. **Put good text with your photos** – Include strong alternative text
2. **Facilitate screen reader navigation** – Use heading labels, give links labels and make them descriptive, incorporate skip links
3. **Write heads-up headlines** – Warn readers of alternative story formats
4. **Offer alternative delivery options** – Social media, newsletters
5. **Use good video/audio players** – Have labeled buttons and the option to view full-screen
6. **Simplify layouts and reduce clutter** – Don't split articles across pages, and reduce redundant and distracting linking
7. **Be careful with advertisements** – Keep them out of the way, and avoid Flash and pop-ups
8. **Get rid of CAPTCHAs** – Try riddles or confirmation emails instead
9. **Offer a mobile site** – And keep it simple
